Background: α -synuclein is a protein of unknown function. It is mainly found in neural tissue. There is a lipid-binding motif

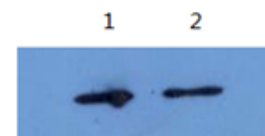
similar to that of Apolipoproteins on its N-terminal. A hydrophobic region that is the non-beta component found in amyloid aggregation in Alzheimer's disease is located at the central region of the protein. The abnormal aggregation of α -synuclein on brain tissue is called Lewy bodies, which are found in Parkinson's disease, dementia and multiply system atrophy. Mutated α -synuclein gene is found to be associated with rare familial form of Parkinson's disease.

Applications:

Indirect ELISA: The antibody reacts with human α -synuclein.

Western Blot: Detect recombinant α -synuclein (α -SYN) using antibody 4H11 at 5 μ g/mL dilution.
